Gilgandra is located 64 Km's North West of Dubbo and is a great little town. First, feel welcome with a sense of community that can only be found in country towns, while you take advantage of the lower cost of living and the additional hours in the day, you will discover while travelling the traffic free roads of our region.

Discover galleries, museums, great walks and fascinating heritage in this country town.

Gilgandra has access to great schools, Public Primary and High as well as Catholic, a Pre-School and a Child Care Centre. Gilgandra has your grocery needs at Supa IGA, beautiful parks, an information centre, a gym clubs and cafes as well as sporting clubs and local pool.

The clinic also has access to regular telehealth clinics with specialists.

GLAMS is a bulk billing clinic, operating between 8:30am and 5pm week days with no weekend shifts. On average GPs are expected to see between 15-20 patients per day.
